

Okada Manila Hosts the 4th Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill

On November 6, 2025, Okada Manila proudly became the first private institution to host the 4th Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) 2025, held in observance of World Tsunami Awareness Day.

In partnership with the Office of Civil Defense – National Capital Region (OCD-NCR) and the Parañaque City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (DRRMO), the property carried out real-time simulations to evaluate evacuation procedures, fire and medical response, and communication systems across key areas of the resort.

Building Readiness Through Collaboration

From simulated ground shaking to coordinated evacuation and response, Okada Manila's teams demonstrated their preparedness in a magnitude 8.3 earthquake and tsunami alert scenario. Departments from Facilities and Security to Human Resources and Hotel Operations worked hand in hand to ensure safety, discipline, and precision throughout the exercise—proving that readiness is strongest when everyone moves as one.
