



Bringing Quality Healthcare Closer to Davao Oriental Communities

Quality healthcare begins with access. In Davao Oriental, Okada Foundation, Inc. (OFI) is helping make that possible through a PHP 165-million healthcare donation that includes medical equipment for the Davao Oriental Provincial Medical Center (DOPMC) and the Super Health Centers in the municipalities of Lupon and San Isidro, as well as a customized mobile clinic for the Super Health Center in Lupon.

The initiative equips healthcare institutions with essential resources that improve patient care and expand access to quality healthcare across the province.

The donation was formally turned over during DOPMC's 55th Founding Anniversary Celebration on July 24, bringing together OFI President James Lorenzana, Dr. Reden V. Bersaldo, Provincial Health Officer II and Chief of Hospital, Senator Christopher Lawrence "Bong" Go, Governor Nelson L. Dayanghirang, and other provincial government officials, healthcare leaders, and guests in a shared commitment to advancing healthcare services in Davao Oriental.

Delivering Essential Healthcare to Davao Oriental Communities

The donation equips the DOPMC and the Super Health Centers in Lupon and San Isidro with essential diagnostic, laboratory, and emergency medical equipment. Complementing these resources is a customized mobile clinic provided to the Super Health Center in Lupon, helping extend essential healthcare services to communities with limited access to medical facilities.

More than providing medical equipment, the initiative reflects OFI's belief that stronger communities begin with accessible healthcare. As healthcare facilities become better equipped, they can care for more patients, respond more effectively to community health needs, and extend essential medical services to more families across the province.
