



Service with Heart in Action: *How OFI is helping strengthen Naga City's public health system*

This issue of Okada Green Heart highlights the work of Okada Foundation, Inc. (OFI), Okada Manila's charitable arm and an important extension of its commitment to responsible and sustainable growth.

In Naga City, OFI's Service with Heart took concrete form through a PHP 135-million healthcare donation designed to strengthen public health services across the city.

Turned over on July 27, the donation supports Naga City General Hospital, City Health Offices I and II, and Our Lady of Lourdes Infirmary. It also provides the City of Naga with a customized mobile clinic and a garbage truck compactor, extending support from healthcare facilities to community access and sanitation.

The initiative reflects OFI's Environment and Health focus and its commitment to working with partners and communities to create meaningful, lasting impact.

Strengthening Care Across the City

OFI's donation supports different levels of care, from routine testing and patient assessment to specialized treatment and critical care.

City Health Offices I and II and Our Lady of Lourdes Infirmary received equipment for laboratory testing, diagnostics, maternal care, sterilization, and other primary healthcare needs, including hematology and chemistry analyzers, portable X-ray units, ECG machines, microscopes, sterilizers, and fetal Dopplers.

Naga City General Hospital received more specialized equipment supporting diagnostic, surgical, maternal, and critical care services, including a 2D echocardiography system, anesthesia machine, arterial blood gas analyzer, and infusion pumps.

These resources strengthen the capabilities of healthcare professionals serving residents every day. City Health Office I serves around 100 patients daily across 10 barangays with an estimated population of 63,000, while Our Lady of Lourdes Infirmary attends to approximately 50 to 60 patients each day.



Bringing Essential Services Closer

The new customized mobile clinic will help bring essential medical services closer to more communities.

The donated garbage truck compactor supports another important part of public health: sanitation. Together with the medical equipment and mobile clinic, it helps strengthen Naga City's broader public health efforts

OFI's PHP 135-million donation strengthens multiple parts of Naga City's public health network—supporting healthcare professionals, improving institutional capabilities, bringing services closer to communities, and supporting cleaner, healthier surroundings.
